An Exhibitor Appointed Contractor (EAC) is a company, **other than Freeman**, the official show contractor, hired by the Exhibitor to set up and dismantle their booth.

Note: EACs **are not permitted** to perform the following exclusive services: Electrical, plumbing, telephone or network services, drayage, rigging, booth cleaning, or catering.

All EACs must comply with the Show Rules & Regulations and all applicable requirements outlined in the Exhibitor Service Kit.
